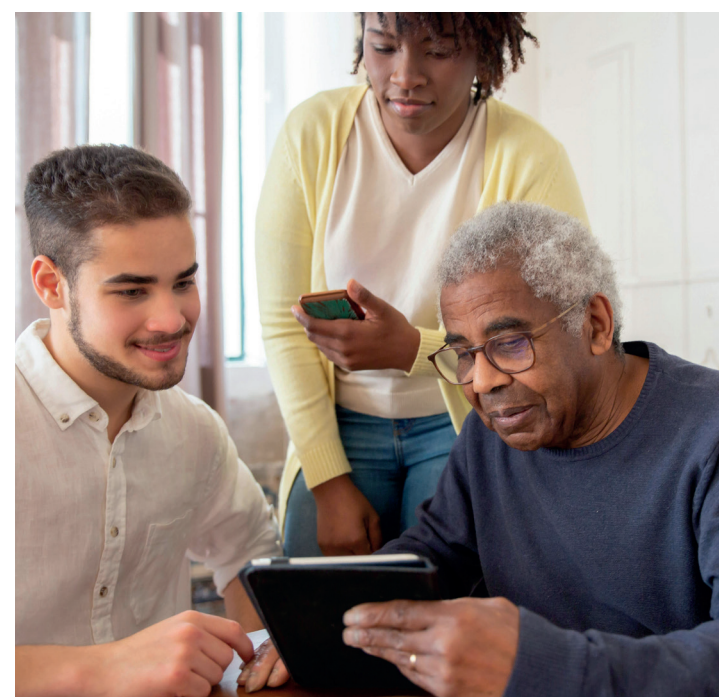
Adjustments?

Any practical change that **reduces disadvantage** related to someone's disability and helps them to access care.

Extra support during appointments

A patient with an impaired memory may need a family member with them at all health interactions to help them understand their treatment.

This is a reasonable adjustment.



Flexible appointments

A person with a mobility issue may need an afternoon appointment because their carer cannot transport them until after 12pm.

This is a reasonable adjustment.

Always ask...

"Do you or someone you care for need any adjustments due to an impairment or disability?"

1. Ask the question
2. Record and share the information
3. Make the reasonable adjustments
